- Enforce camp policies and camper rules
- Other duties as assigned by camp session director

Qualifications

A successful volunteer counselor will be:

- At least 18 years of age
- Mature in their walk with Jesus Christ
- Able to live and work in agreement with Camp Challenge's code of conduct and core values
- Passionate about outdoor ministry
- Highly responsible and teachable
- Aware of their own personality traits and how those manifest in a team setting
- Comfortable with campers of varying backgrounds and ages (1st-12th grades)
- Recommended by their current pastor
- Able to pass a criminal history background check

Time Commitment

- Staff and volunteer training retreat (Fri evening-Sat afternoon the 3rd weekend in May)
- 2 hours prior to camp check-in opening day until 1 hour after pick-up closing day
